Explore and immerse yourselves in learning all about the negatives of plastic pollution and see if you can learn 3 facts.

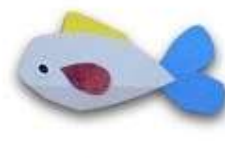
CHALLENGE FOUR:

Use plastic to make a display

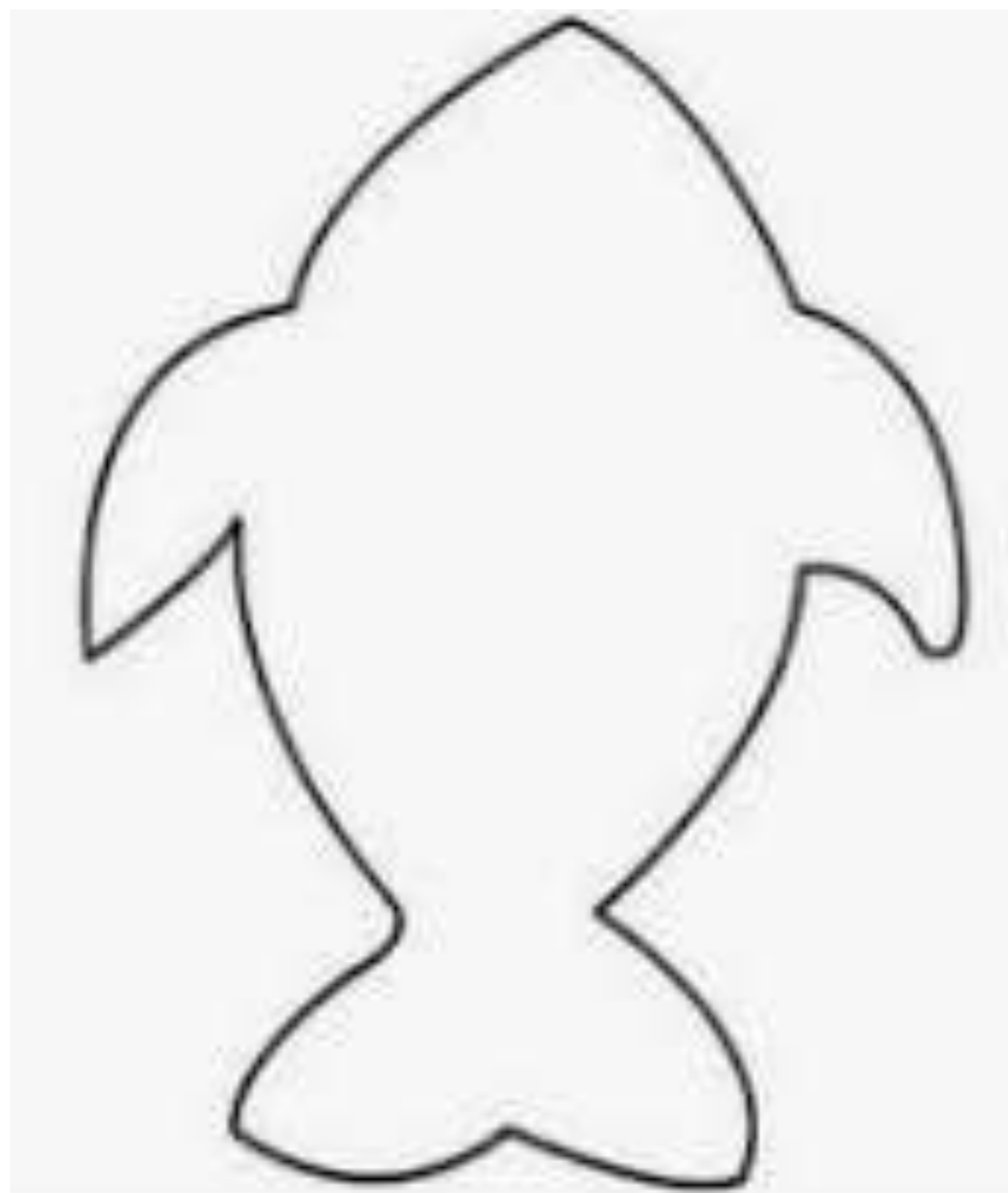

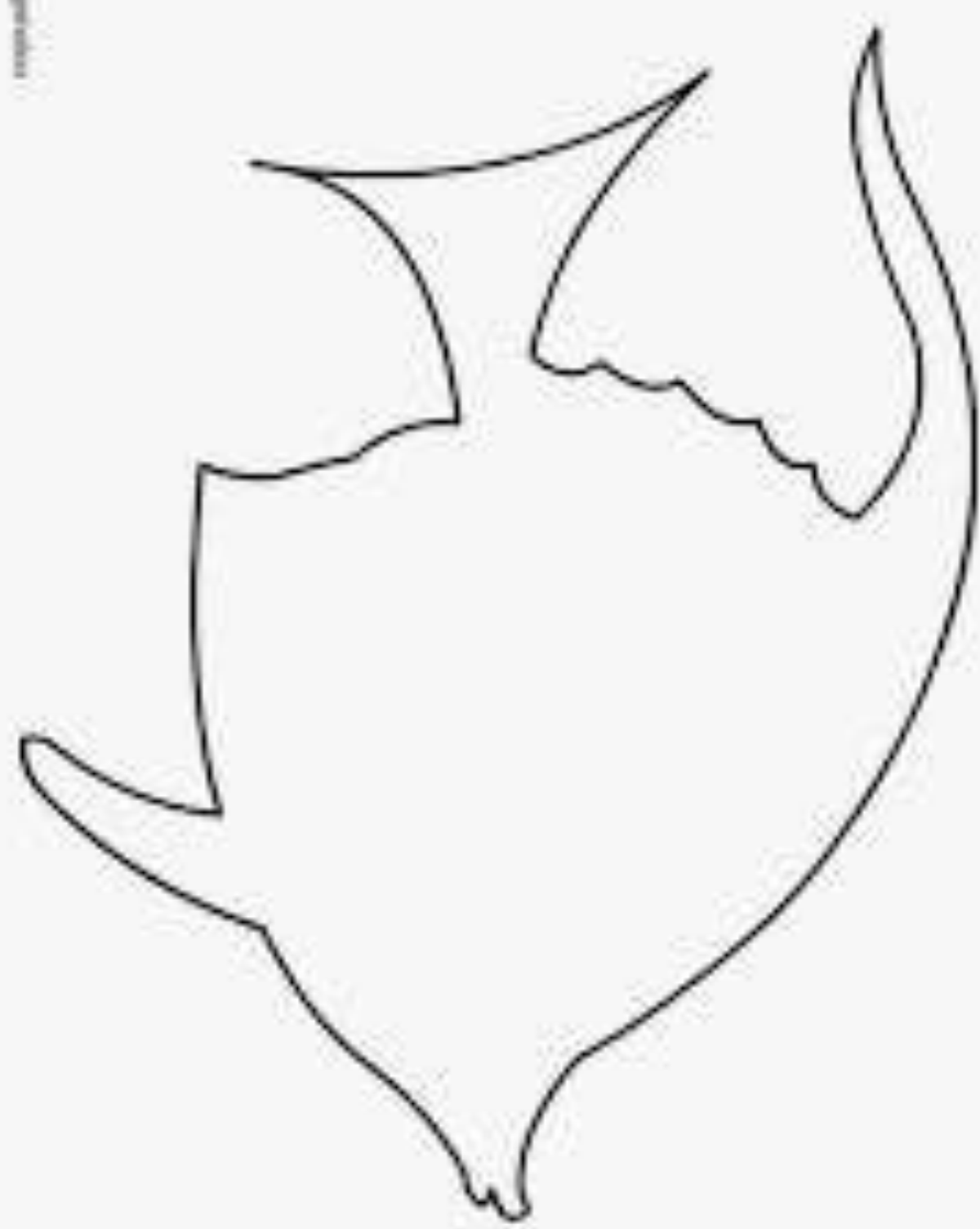


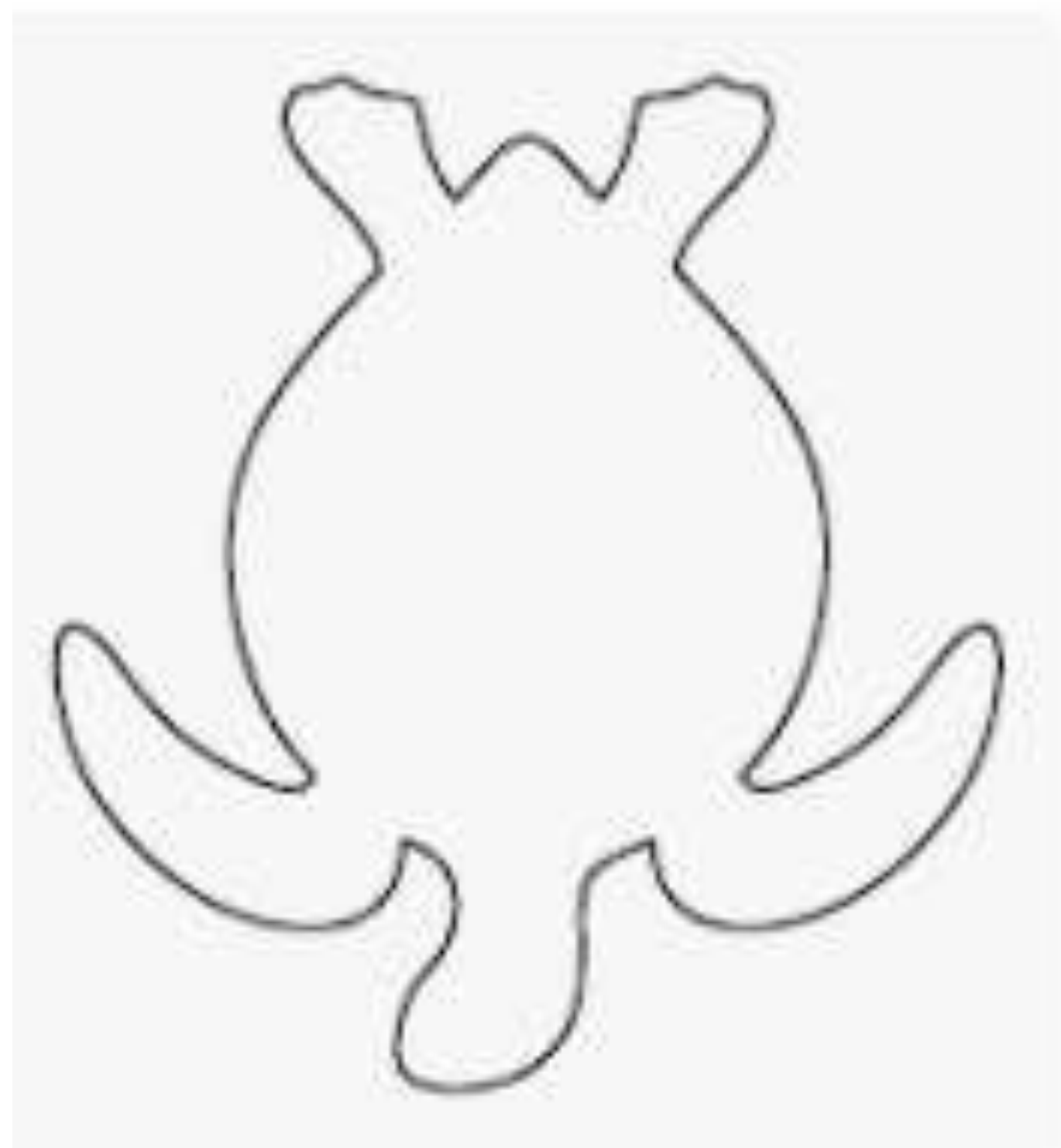
Fish, turtle, dolphin, seahorse, octopus
